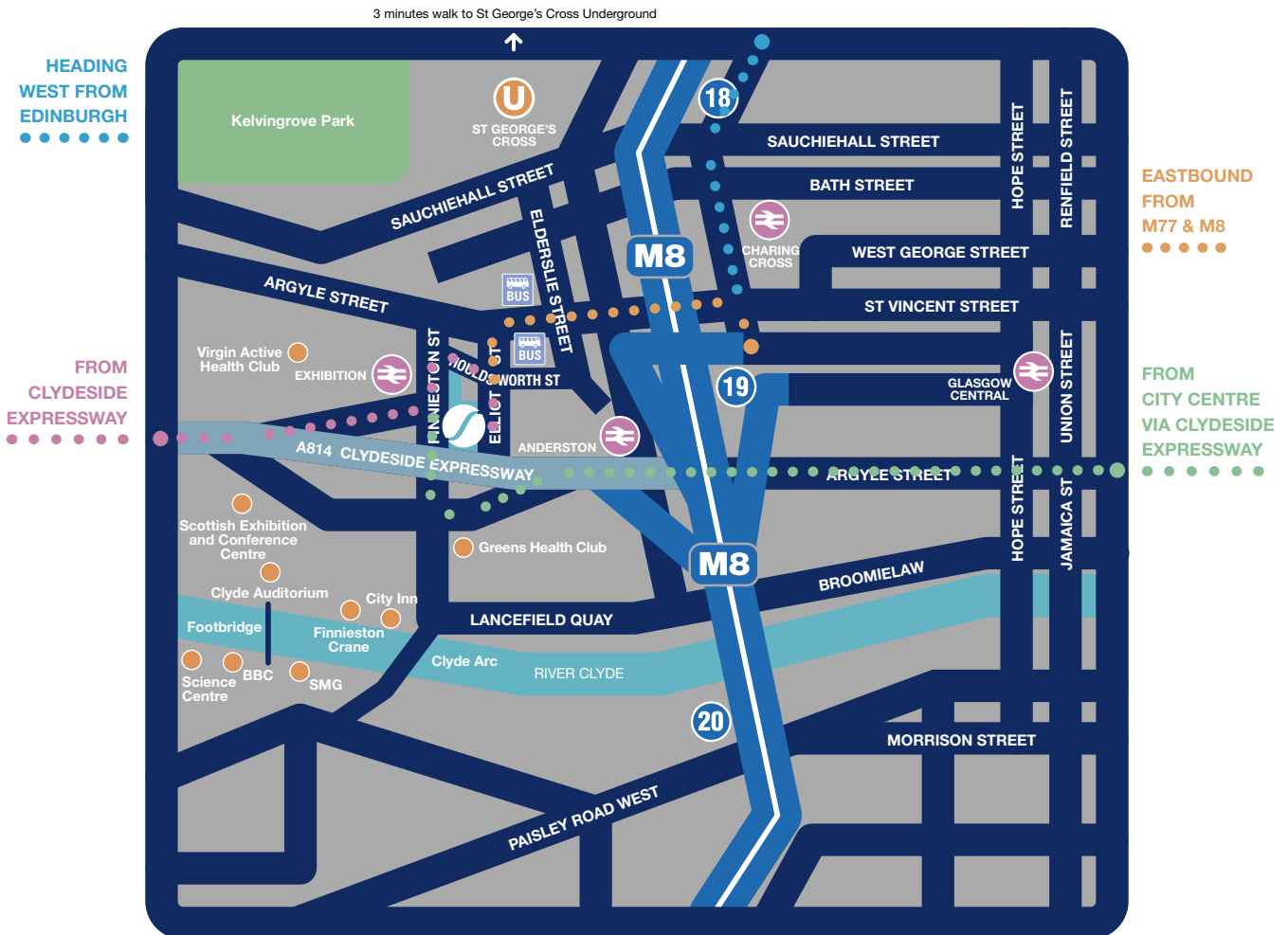


# How to get to Glasgow's unrivalled landmark business complex

## By car and bicycle



Skypark offers visitor car parking and is easily reached from the M8, M77 and Clydeside Expressway.

### From the Clydeside Expressway – Travelling to the City Centre

Take the Finnieston/SECC exit.  
At the traffic lights turn left onto Finnieston Street.  
At McDonalds turn right onto Houldsworth Street.  
At the junction of Elliot Street and Houldsworth Street turn right.  
Drive up the ramp and you will be directed to the visitor's car park.

### From the Clydeside Expressway – Travelling from the City Centre

Take the Finnieston/SECC exit.  
At the traffic lights turn right onto Finnieston Street.  
At McDonalds turn right onto Houldsworth Street.  
At the junction of Elliot Street and Houldsworth Street turn right.  
Drive up the ramp and you will be directed to the visitor's car park.

### From the M77 & M8 – Travelling Eastbound into the City Centre

Take the Bothwell Street City Centre fly-over (Junction 19).  
Turn left at the traffic lights.  
Turn left again at the traffic lights onto St Vincent Street.  
Straight through the next three sets of traffic lights across the M8.  
Straight through the next set of traffic lights at Elderslie Street.  
First left before the police station onto Elliot Street.  
Drive up the ramp and you will be directed to the visitor's car park.

### From the M8 – Heading west from Edinburgh

Take the Charing Cross slip road on the right hand side of the motorway.  
Stay in the right hand lane and go through 2 sets of traffic lights.  
At the next set of lights, take a right onto St. Vincent St.  
Straight through the next set of traffic lights at Elderslie Street.  
First left before the police station onto Elliot Street.  
Drive up the ramp and you will be directed to the visitor's car park.



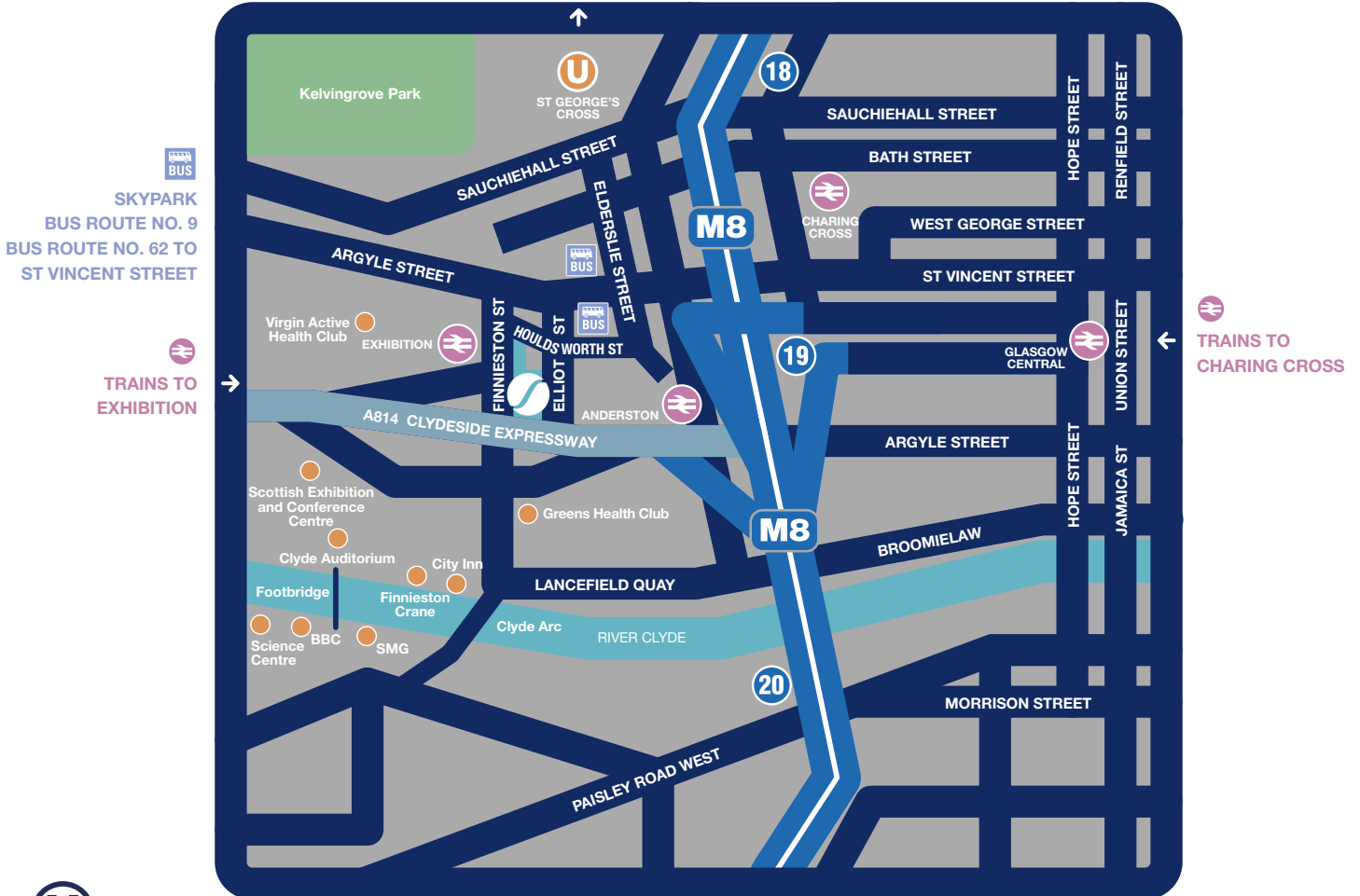
Skypark has its own bicycle rack where your staff can leave their bicycles in safety and free of charge!

# How to get to Glasgow's unrivalled landmark business complex

## By public transport

3 minutes walk to St George's Cross Underground



The closest underground station to Skypark is St. Georges Cross, fifteen minutes walk from Skypark.



Skypark is adjacent to the Exhibition Rail Station which connects directly to Glasgow Central low level. Charing Cross Station is 10 minutes walk and connects directly to Glasgow Queen Street low level.

**Services which connect into the Exhibition Railway Station: Route 24**

- Helensburgh Central – Lanark
- Dalmuir – Lanark
- Dalmuir – Motherwell
- Milngavie – Motherwell and Lanark

**Services which connect into Charing Cross Railway Station: Route 23**

- Helensburgh – Airdrie
- Balloch – Drumgelloch
- Dalmuir – Airdrie
- Milngavie – Springburn
- Hyndland - Bellgrove



Skypark is easily placed for connections into the Glasgow overground bus services. Below are the routes which connect close to Skypark on St Vincent Street.

**Route Number 9**

Drumchapel, Lincoln Avenue/Great Western Road, Scotstoun, Partick, City Centre, Central Station, Paisley Road Toll, Halfway, Paisley, Linwood. During the day these run every 10 minutes.

**Route Number 62**

Faifley, Clydebank, Scotstoun, Partick, City Centre, Central Station, Glasgow Cross, Parkhead Cross, Shettleston, Baillieston. During the day these run every 6 minutes.
